

President's Order No. 136 of 1972

THE STATE ACQUISITION AND TENANCY (FIFTH AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1972

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the State Acquisition and Tenancy Act, 1950 (E. B. Act XXVIII of 1951), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

Now, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of Independence of Bangladesh, read with the Provisional Constitution of Bangladesh Order, 1972, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make the following Order:—

- 1. (1) This Order may be called the State Acquisition and Tenancy (Fifth Amendment) Order, 1972.
- . (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the third day of August, 1972.

2. In section 95A of the State Acquisition and Tenancy Act, 1950 (E.B. Act XXVIII of 1951), after the words and comma "any transfer of a holding or of a portion or share thereof," the words and comma "either by way of an out and out sale with an agreement to reconvey," shall be inserted.
